


THE PRIMARY OBJECTIVE of the Nordic Joint Committee for Agricultural and Food Research (NKJ) is to contribute to promote and coordinate a knowledge-based agriculture and food sector in the Nordic countries. To meet this end, NKJ encourages and provides support to joint Nordic cooperation within agriculture and food research, including forestry and fishery.



THE NKJ WAS ESTABLISHED in 1965 by the Nordic Council of Ministers. The committee's main stakeholders are the Nordic Council of Ministers, the national ministries responsible for agricultural and food research in the Nordic countries, the national research councils, as well as Nordic researchers in the NKJ's area of responsibility within agriculture and food, and also within other sectors, such as forestry and fisheries where relevant.

The NKJ also cooperates with a wide array of Nordic institutes and bodies under the auspices of the Nordic Council of Ministers.
