

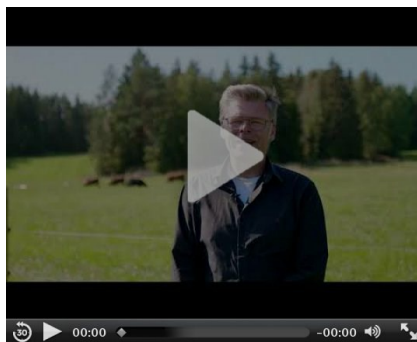

Pave the way for Nordic cooperation on soil as a carbon sink

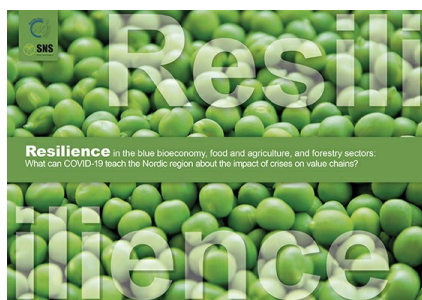
